#### School Fees & Levies 2023

#### Dear Family,

The setting of school fees and levies is an annual process in preparation for the year ahead. The process involves a review of current fees and levies in light of the annual budget and consultation with the school board. This year we have worked particularly hard to keep any cost increases to an absolute minimum. Below is an outline of school fees and levies for the 2023 school year.

School Fees (family fee):

#### **Per Student Levy**

This levy covers a range of expenses, including; classroom supplies, technology and specialist programs.

Year Prep - Three:

\$270

Year Four - Six:

\$440

#### **Learning Experiences Levy**

This levy covers camp, excursion, incursions and physical education costs.

Year Prep - Two:

\$150

Year Three - Four:

\$150 + \$230 Billabong Camp (October 2023)

Year Five - Six:

\$150 + \$280 Sunnystones Camp (October 2023)
